

Sustainable Field Practices

Two Guiding Principles and Thirteen Practices

RESPECT the Environment - Mind Our Steps

- Restore excavation sites as close to original as possible.
- Existing disturbed areas should be used for walking; consider drones for surveys.
- Sanitize field gear & vehicles to prevent invasive species spread.
- Protect plants— Bend, don't break to avoid unnecessary damage.
- Environmentally safe sunscreen only —reef-safe, non-toxic.
- Clean up all waste leave nothing behind.
- Tread lightly—drive on roads and avoid parking on dry vegetation.

REDUCE Waste - Minimize Our Footprint

- Recycle.
- Employ sustainable gear reuse and avoid single-use items.
- Digital data collection whenever possible.
- Use biodegradable flagging tape & pin flags when possible.
- Carpool when feasible.
- Eliminate unnecessary idling (except for safety reasons).
